1. One (1) 8-ft long x 4-ft wide x 18-inch deep raised garden frame
(or two (2) 4-ft long x 4-ft wide x 18-inch deep raised garden frames)
2. 13 – 3 cubic feet blocks of topsoil
3. 3 – 3 cubic feet blocks of compost
4. 2 – 3 cubic feet blocks of soilless growing mix (peat moss)
5. Herb Seedlings:
 - Basil – One (1) 6-pack each of all varieties
 - Bay Laurel – One (1) gal container
 - Borage – One (1) 4” pot
 - Caraway – One (1) 4” pot
